



St Joseph's College

Uniform Guidelines

Students at St Joseph's College are expected to wear their uniform correctly and to take pride in their appearance at all times including the journey to and from school; therefore uniform standards must be adhered to **at all times. Students must remember that they represent St Joseph's College and are ambassadors for the school especially when in uniform.**

All students Years 1 - 6

Blazers should be worn at all times and all students' shirts and blouses must be tucked in. Shoes must be black leather – not patent, and kept clean and polished. Only navy blue or black coats are allowed to be worn, without logos. Scarves and jumpers must be the official College design and purchased from Coes. Hair must remain its natural colour. No make-up, nail varnish or jewellery may be worn; a watch or subtle item of religious significance is permitted.

Girls Years 1 – 6

Shoes must have a modest and safe heel. Only white socks or navy blue tights can be worn. Girls may wear a small plain silver or gold stud earring in the lobe of each ear. If the hair touches the shoulder it must be tied back completely and kept clear from the face. Hair fashion accessories are not permitted.

Boys Years 1 – 6

Trousers and shorts must be grey and socks must be grey as available from Coes. Boys' hair should be no shorter than a Grade 3 and no longer than collar length. Hair should be short enough to be kept clear from the face.

All students Years 7 -11

No make-up, nail varnish or jewellery may be worn; a watch or subtle item of religious significance is permitted. Shoes must be black leather – not patent, and kept clean and polished. Only navy blue or black coats are allowed to be worn, without logos. Scarves and jumpers must be the official College design and purchased from Coes. Blazers should be worn at all times and all students' shirts and blouses must be tucked in (except for girls in Years 10 and 11 where the design of the blouse does not allow this) Hair colour must be of a natural shade.

Girls Years 7 – 11

If the hair touches the shoulder it must be tied back completely. Hair fashion accessories are not permitted. Stiletto and sling back shoes are inappropriate footwear for school. Shoes must have a modest and safe heel. Only navy blue or flesh coloured tights and navy blue socks can be worn. Girls may wear a small stud earring in the lobe of each ear.

Boys Years 7 – 11

Boys' hair should be no shorter than a Grade 3 and no longer than collar length. Hair should be short enough to be kept clear from the face. Boys should be clean shaven at all times. Trousers must be dark/charcoal grey and socks must be grey or black only

Sixth Form

Sixth Form students are expected to lead the College in terms of their own dress code. Although they have the privilege of choosing the formal style of their own suit, they have the responsibility to promote the very highest standards of appearance. They are encouraged to express individual flair but they should also show good judgement to demonstrate the appropriate sophistication, elegance and maturity required.
